This club starts at 12:05 after students eat their lunch.

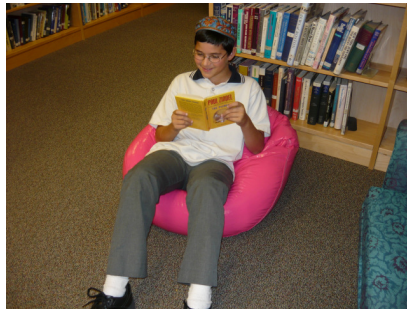


Thursday Book Club
